The electrical trade has long been associated with high earning power, which is directly tied to the importance of their work. On average, electricians now earn nearly \$5,000 more yearly than the average college graduate (NPR, 2015).

The *US Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS)* reported that the average annual salary for electricians was \$51,880, as of May 2015, with the top 10 percent earning more than \$88,130.
